Attention Horsemen: Any scratches after Wednesday, October 19 must be made with the Presiding Steward, Tad Zimmerman (540) 539-1502 and shall only be made based on the recommendation of a veterinarian.

Post time for the first race is 12:00 noon. Riders must be present and signed in to the Jockey area by 10:30. You may then continue a course walk as long as you are present for the Stewards meeting.

There will be a mandatory jockeys meeting with the Stewards at 11:00 a.m. There will be an officials meeting immediately following the Jockeys meeting at the Stewards Stand at 11:25 a.m.

Note: Jockey fees for non-winners in flat races at the International Gold Cup will be \$100.

Credentials Needed: All owners, trainers, riders and grooms participating in the International Gold Cup races are required to be licensed by the Virginia Racing Commission (VRC). (Please note: anyone licensed in the spring for the 2016 Virginia Gold Cup races does not need to get a new license for this event; just make sure to bring your badge from the spring races with you.) The easiest way to obtain a license is by going to the Commission's website at www.vrc.virginia.gov and clicking on "Virginia Racing License" in the upper left hand side of the home page. You will then see a list of documents including the "Racing Application for Participants", "General Application Instructions", "Fee Schedule", and "Credit Card Verification Form". Simply print out the application and complete it by referring to the fee schedule and general instructions. Once the application is completed, signed, and dated you may either mail it along with the appropriate payment to 5707 Huntsman Road, Suite 201-B, Richmond, VA 23250 or scan the application and e-mail it to VRCLicense@vrc.virginia.gov. If you would like the badge mailed to you before the races, your application and payment must be received by October 14th, otherwise badges will be distributed at the horsemen's check-in tent located in the stable area. The VRC will also be on site at the Spring House on Thursday October 20th from 11:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. and on Friday October 21st from 9:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. for licensing. (Please note: All licensing needs to be completed by Friday, October 21st.) If you have any questions or require assistance with this process please contact Dave Lermond at (804) 840-3325. Owners and trainers, etc. participating in the flat races only do not need to be credentialed by NSA. Grooms must have a VRC license unless they have a current license from another Jurisdiction, in which case they may obtain a day pass.

A horsemen's check-in tent will be located in the stable area to handout and sell wristbands (only needed for those without a license). Horsemen will receive 4 complimentary wristbands per participating owner, trainer and jockey; additional wristbands may be purchased at \$35 each. The 2016 NSA mirror-hung car pass will admit the vehicle to Gate 2. The NSA pin will allow entrance to Members Hill only. Anyone with questions can contact the VGCA office at 540-347-2612.

SADDLING IN THE STABLE AREA:

Please be advised that the VGCA has obtained a change in the VRC statutes that will now allow saddling in the stable. Therefore, ALL horses will be saddled in the stable area and will then be led to the paddock TOGETHER. The trainer or their designate will be responsible for transporting the tack after weighing out back to the barn for saddling. The jockeys are not allowed in the stabling area. Please note post time for each race and have your horse ready to parade to the paddock at the appropriate time. If trainers have multiple horses in a race or horses in back to back races, please make appropriate plans as it is imperative that we stay on schedule.

International Gold Cup Races will have Pari-Mutuel wagering and be subject to the authority of the Virginia Racing Commission. Private veterinarians are prohibited to have contact with horses prior to racing. Veterinarians and trainers are encouraged refer to the Virginia Medication Synopsis (updated April 2016) found on the homepage of the Virginia Racing Commissions website (www.vrc.virginia.gov) or contact the Racing Commission State Veterinarian, Dr. Richard Harden, with any specific medication questions at 804-966-7409 or 804-840-1418.

A veterinary exam is required for all horses. Examinations will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end by 11:00 a.m.

ALL HORSES (WHETHER ON LASIX OR NOT) MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 10:00 A.M. FOR THE PRE-RACE VET EXAM.

ALL HORSES MUST BE TATTOOED.

FOAL PAPERS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE ON FILE WITH THE HORSE IDENTIFIER.

THIRD PARTY FUROSEMIDE (SALIX) ADMINISTRATION

Horsemen are reminded that third party administration of furosemide (Salix) is in effect at this race meet. Please refer to the 2016 NSA Fall Condition Book (center color section) for complete details of the NSA Medication policy. Contact Dr. Jeff Witwer (803-243-0328). ALL LASIX HORSES MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS NO LATER THAN 4 HOURS PRIOR TO POST TIME FOR THEIR RACE. However, all horses must be on the grounds no later 10:00 a.m. for the pre-race veterinary exams.

Horses shipping to International Gold Cup must have a health certificate with the following information: Horses have not originated from a barn with a case or suspect case of Herpes virus; been vaccinated with EHV-1 no less than seven days and no more than 90 days; and a coggins test conducted within 12 months.

Stabling - Stalls will be provided for each entry. For special accommodations and bedding contact Thomas C. Williams (Reggie) at 703-843-6385. Note: Licensed grooms are for hire by contacting T.C. Williams (703-843-6385).

Apprentice allowances must be claimed at the time of entry and all horses MUST be saddled in the stable area.

NSA Horsemen's pins will be honored at the gate to Members Hill but will not admit vehicles at gates. Owners and trainers are encouraged to view the races from the Owner/Trainer Deck or the nearby Chairman's Box. The race committee asks that use of the viewing stand and paddock be restricted to owners and trainers of horses in that race. Please be considerate of those running horses, since there is limited space. Luncheon near the Stewards Stand from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. After Race Party honoring the Gold Cup winner will commence after the last race.

The easiest way to obtain a license is by going to the Commission's website at www.vrc.virginia.gov and clicking on "Virginia Racing License" in the upper left hand side of the home page. You will then see a list of documents including the "Racing Application for Participants", "General Application Instructions", "Fee Schedule", and "Credit Card Verification Form". Simply print out the application and complete it by referring to the fee schedule and general instructions. Once the application is completed, signed, and dated you may either mail it along with the appropriate payment to 5707 Huntsman Road, Suite 201-B, Richmond, VA 23250 or scan the application and e-mail it to VRCLicense@vrc.virginia.gov. If you would like the badge mailed to you before the races, your application and payment must be received by October 14th, otherwise badges will be distributed at the horsemen's check-in tent located in the stable area. The VRC will also be on site at the Spring House on Thursday October 20th from 11:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. and on Friday October 21st from 9:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. for licensing. (Please note: All licensing needs to be completed by Friday, October 21st.) If you have any questions or require assistance with this process please contact Dave Lermond at (804) 840-3325. Owners and trainers participating in the flat races only do not need to be credentialed by NSA. Grooms must have a VRC license unless they have a current license from another Commission in which case they may obtain a day pass. A horsemen's check-in tent will be located in the stable area. Horsemen will receive 4 complimentary guest passes per participating owner (**only needed for those without a VRC license**). Trainers and jockeys will receive 1 complimentary o/t/r wristband. **Important notice: the wristbands do not allow admittance to the stable or paddock areas but it does allow entrance to Members Hill and the Hospitality Tent (Guest pass admits to both).** The 2016 NSA mirror-hung car pass, or VRC license will admit the vehicle to Gate 2. The NSA pin will allow entrance to Members Hill only. Anyone with questions can contact the VGCA office at 540-347-2612. There will be a Stable Hospitality Tent which will be located on the east side of the stable tent, to provide coffee, doughnuts, lunch and sodas for those horsemen who cannot leave the stable area.

Directions: All Gold Cup car passes have specific directions on the back -- please follow the directions for each specific Gate. **Directions for the Horsemen's Gate:** **From Washington:** Take I-66 West to Exit 43A onto Rt. 29 South for approximately 11 miles toward Warrenton. Take exit for Rt. 17 North toward Winchester for 8 miles to Old Tavern Road (also Rt. 245) on right. Do not join right hand lane on Rt. 17 waiting to enter Gate 8.

From Middleburg: West on Rt. 50 from Middleburg, then South on Zulla Road (also Rt. 709), then left on Rt. 17 South and left on Old Tavern Road (Rt. 245).

From Warrenton and South: North on Rt. 17, then right on Old Tavern Road (Rt. 245). Proceed directly to Rt. 245, do not join in the right hand lane waiting to enter Gate 8 on Rt. 17.

From Leesburg: Take Rt. 15 South to I-66 West at Haymarket; take Exit 28 to Rt. 17 South, turn left on Rt. 845 (Old Winchester Road).
