

### How do I place a wager?

Self-service terminals are located on Member's Hill, North Side and South Side. There are a total of 11 betting stations. Please refer to your Race Day Program Guest map for location nearest you. The self-service touch screen terminals are fan friendly and easy to use.

### How much do I have to bet?

The minimum amount to be wagered is \$2. For Exacta, Daily Double and Trifecta wagers, you may make bets in increments of \$1, so long as the number of combinations wagered on totals at least \$2

### How do I place the wager at the terminal?

Select RACE NUMBER

Select AMOUNT of the bet

Select TYPE of bet

Select the NUMBER of the horse(s)

Example: 4<sup>th</sup> Race, \$2 Win on 3



### How are the odds determined?

The track handicapper sets the morning line, which are the odds the horses will be at post time. As money is wagered, the odds change continuously until post time, and are determined by the amount of money wagered on each horse.

### When does the wagering close for each race?

Wagering closes when the horses reach the start. No wagering will be allowed after the start of the race.

### How do I find out if I won?

Check the Jumbotron/Tote Board or any betting terminal after the race becomes official as announced. The amount you win depends on how much you wager, the type of bet you make and the horse's odds.

### What happens if there is a late scratch?

This depends on what type of wager it is. If a horse is scratched, refunds will be given on Win, Place, Show, Exacta, and Trifecta wagers.

### Very Important: Hold all tickets until the race is official

Make sure you hold all tickets until results are made official, as there could be changes in the order of finish due to disqualification. For your convenience and ease in speedily cashing winning tickets, it is requested that your tickets not be torn, folded or otherwise damaged.

### Bet Cancellation Policy

Please examine your tickets carefully before leaving the terminal. Cancellations can only be made prior to the start of the race and betting amount is less than \$250.

### Rule for Uncashed Tickets

All tickets must be cashed by 6:30 PM. All wagering sites will be closed after 6:30PM and will be unable to honor any winning ticket. Please call the Gold Cup office (540-347-2612) for tickets not cashed out.

### Do I have to report my winnings to the IRS?

The Internal Revenue Service requires reporting of payouts on wagers that exceed odds of 300 to 1 and pay in excess of \$600. IRS regulations also require automatic withholding on payouts that exceed \$5,000. When cashing an IRS ticket, patrons must present a valid picture, government issued ID. A second form of identification showing the patron's social security number must also be presented.

### Race Day Wagering Options

**Win:** The horse must finish first

**Place:** The horse must finish first or second (you collect the amount for second)

**Show:** The horse must finish first, second or third (you collect the amount for third)

**Exacta:** You must pick the horses that finish first AND second in exact order

**Trifecta:** You must pick the horses that finish first, second AND third in exact order

**Daily Double:** Selection of the winners of two consecutive races. (Excludes the last race)
